Admissions

Admissions are on first come first serve basis. Seats are limited and students are advised to apply early in order to avoid disappointment. Rolling admission is followed. IFNMU is a Govt. University. Fees are Reasonable. There are NO DONATIONS. Students passed / appearing in class 12 board examinations are eligible to apply. Candidates from India should pass in each subject of PCB examination with minimum 50% average in PCB. (40% for SC/ST/OBC) in class 12th Board Examination. There is additional cost for Visa, Medical Test, Legalization, Translation, Documentation, Processing etc

Visa Arrangement

To enter Ukraine for Higher Education, students have to submit complete documents to the Embassy of Ukraine in their country for issue of a visa. The University will issue a "Letter of Invitation" registered with the Ministry of Education, Ukraine. The "Letter of Invitation" includes the full name of the student, his/her date of birth and passport number. The Embassy of Ukraine will issue a visa in the home country between 15th of August to the 15th of October. The student has to enter Ukraine before the 15th of October. Complete documents have to be carried to Ukraine and have to be presented once again at the passport control office in the port of Entry.

How to get to Ivano-Frankivsk

By Plane - Ivano-Frankivsk has a domestic and international airport which is served by flight from Moscow (Russia), Warsaw (Poland), Istanbul (Turkey) and several airports in Ukraine.

By Train & Bus - Ivano-Frankivsk is well connected by train and bus by most major cities in Ukraine and Poland, Bulgaria, Romania and Slovakia.

Ukraine is in one time zone, which is 2 hours ahead of GMT and 3% hours after India.

Currency

The Ukrainian National Currency is Hryvnia (UAH). Foreign currency can be exchanged at many points in Ukraine in Banks and local currency dealers. Approx 1 UAH = 6 Indian Rupees.







Documents that the Applicants have to submit to the University:

- » Application in the name of the Rector
- » Certificate of school graduation with names of subjects and marks, translated into Ukrainian and attested by the Embassy of Ukraine.
- » Birth Certificate translated into Ukrainian and attested by Embassy of Ukraine.
- » Certificate of Absence of HIV infection
- » Medical Certificate on the Health Status of the student and issued within 2 months from the date of entering Ukraine for education.
- » 30 passport photos of 6x4 cms
- » Valid Passport
