International Explore

During the clinical phase 2 of the MBBS Medicine course, students undertake a special study module, which allows some students to spend this four-week period on a student-led exchange in a European country. Past destinations have included Poland, Germany, Slovakia and Spain. Students on all of our medical courses also have the opportunity to spend their compulsory elective period (clinical phase three) abroad, which has included destinations such as UAE, Africa, Israel, Thailand, Vietnam, India and China.

Program overview

The MBBS degree consists of three major streams reflecting the core elements of medical practice:

- 1. Scientific basis of medicine
- 2. Clinical practice
- 3. Medical professional and personal development

A major emphasis is placed on professionalism, communication, clinical reasoning, and evidence-based and preventive medicine. Case-based, small-group learning (CBL) is the dominant learning mode during the early years of the curriculum. Learning is structured around clinical cases of the most common and important diseases. Lectures in medical disciplines such as pathology, anatomy, physiology and pharmacology are carefully staged throughout the CBL cases.

In year 1, students will also undertake two semesters of Fundamentals of Biomedical Science, a course specifically designed for medical students. The Clinical Skills and Medical Professional and Personal Development courses begin in week 1 and assist students to acquire the skills required for effective clinical practice. The Clinical Practice tutorials in years 1 and 2 are led by senior clinicians in a state-of-theart clinical skills facility.

In year 3, clinical skills training is conducted primarily in the public teaching hospitals. Students will then bring this core learning to their clinical placements in years 4–6. These placements will be held in a wide range of organizations, including public teaching hospitals and the broader medical and health community. There are some clinical placements that all students must take, but there are also opportunities for students to choose from a range of electives. Some students will be able to undertake year 5 in a rural setting.

Year 6 is focused on what students need to know for their internship. The major clinical examinations are completed at the end of year 5 and, with the pressure of exams reduced, students can focus on their clinical practice and professional development.

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Study Plan

Years 1-3

From day one, learning will be inspired by clinical cases, with students learning clinical skills and working with surrogate patients. Students will have access to state-of-the-art anatomy, health simulation and clinical skills laboratories. While there are lectures, much learning will occur in small group tutorials. The following three streams form the grounding of the first three years. They provide opportunities to acquire the core knowledge that will allow students to advance and fully participate in the clinical attachments offered in years 4–6.

>> Scientific basis of medicine:

Learning about the science that supports the practice of medicine.

>> Clinical practice:

Hands-on tutorials in a dedicated clinical skills laboratory, often working with surrogate patients. In year 3 students undertake a full day each week of clinical skills study in a hospital setting. When students start their clinical attachments in year 4 they will already have gained familiarity with hospital protocol.

>> Medical professional and personal development:

Professionalism, ethics, communication, leadership - all essential to quality medical practice.

Each year level also has additional courses to assist students as they progress through the clinical cases that are core to years 1–3 of the degree.

- Year 1: Fundamentals of Biomedical Science
- Year 2: Medical Microbiology and Immunology plus an elective
- Year 3: Research and Clinical Reasoning.

The Medical University of

Rostov state

Rostov State Medical University is the successor of Russian Warsaw University, evacuated to Rostov-on-Don and converted into The Don University. The best representatives of the medical schools of Warsaw, Moscow, St. Petersburg and Kazan were collected on its medical faculty and have founded their own unique Rostov medical school, which has become one of the best in Russia.

In 1930, the Medical Faculty of the University was reorganized into the Institute of Medicine, which has become the largest medical university in the South of the USSR.

In the 50s, the Institute has grown significantly, the university became the first category, won the right to conduct defense of dissertations for awarding the degree of Doctor of Science. It has organized the Evening Department and the Faculty for Advanced Training of physicians.

In the 60s, there were opened The Central Scientific Research Laboratory, The Preparatory Faculty on Training Foreign Citizens, several new departments, and at the same time there was improved clinical base.

In 1994, the Institute was granted University status, and then there were organized several new faculties.

Today The Rostov State Medical University is the largest medical research center in Southern Russia.

Today in the Rostov State Medical University operate 92 departments, the youngest of them is the Department of Medical Law. More than six hundred teachers are constantly working introducing innovations and interactive forms of learning.

Among them there are more than 119 Doctors of Science, professors and about 350 PhDs. The academicians and professors who are working at our University now continue to develop the best traditions of their predecessors.

The Rostov State Medical University develops international scientific cooperation with many countries exchanging scientific staff, students, teachers, highly qualified specialists and participating in international scientific conferences and congresses.

In recent years the centralization and automation of many diagnostic and medical departments of our University allowed to concentrate and rationally use the staff, medical equipment, improve the quality of work of each structural unit and create a technology of continuous medical-diagnostic process.

The Rector puts particular emphasis on the organization of the educational process at the University. Nowadays we implement interactive forms of training and computerize of educational process. The best professors and doctors of the University have the opportunity to undergo course of internship in medical clinics and universities of Europe.







International students

Rostov State Medical University has been training specialists for foreign countries since 1961 is highly appreciated abroad. In 1964 the Dean's office of Faculty on Training Foreign Students and Postgraduates was organized. Foreign students are trained at the faculties of General Medicine, Pediatrics, Pharmacy and Stomatology. Annually the University produces about 100 foreign specialists from about 100 countries of India, Africa, and Latin America. In recent years the number of students from CIS countries, Baltic States, The Ukraine, Kazakhstan, Tajikistan, and Turkmenistan has significantly increased. Students from different countries live as one big friendly family successfully obtaining one of the most noble and humane professions — medical one. The best foreign students are the scholarship holders of The Potanin's Charity Fund.

Training foreign citizens on the postgraduate stage at the University has been carrying out since 1965. Elena S. Yasanis has been supervising foreign interns and postgraduate students for 12 years. Approximately 100 specialists are trained in the internship, residency and postgraduate (Ph.D.) course at the Rostov State Medical University. Annually 4-5 foreign postgraduates successfully defend their thesis with awarding the scientific title Ph.D. Young scientists-foreigners represent our University at international congresses and symposia on actual problems of medicine in Italy, France, Sweden, Germany, USA, Turkey and other countries.

An innovated University with old traditions

The Rostov State Medical University was founded in 1930 as one of the first universities in Southern Russia. Since 1963, when the Medical Faculty was built up, the University contributes to the flourishing of the "academic-city" Rostov-na-Donu. In 1983, the Medical University starts 3 research centers, 20 clinics and 7 institutes and 1.500 employees. At the moment about 8.000 students are registered at the Medical University of Rostov.

Three focuses:

Teaching, Research and **medical care at the university hospital** at the highest standard of quality are the three focuses of the Medical University of Rostov. The philosophy of our university is to combine biological, psychological and social aspects in the fields of research, study programs and medical care. Due to the tense network between the three main tasks, we achieve the maximum of medical and scientific progress.


High quality education


