

A Statement Regarding the SSPP School Building

SS. Peter and Paul School is a ministry of the Parish of Mary, Mother of the Church. The difficult decision to no longer operate the school at the conclusion of this current academic year has been made. The final official day of classes will be June 15, 2019. Following that date, there is a necessary period of clean up and other end of year procedures, with additional actions now required related to the proper facilitation of the school closure. Our pastoral focus is on the well-being of the students and staff and the ongoing educational experience until the final day of class. In addition, as is the case in many parishes, the building serves multiple purposes beyond the operating of a parochial school.

As of now, the parish leadership has not received, reviewed, or rejected any proposals regarding the future use of the building. The parish leadership has not yet actively pursued proposals regarding the future use of the school building. The parish leadership is open to doing so, within a reasonable time frame and in light of our parish needs. As we approach the end of the school year, this ongoing process of discernment will continue. As appropriate these matters will be discussed within the parish, assessments will be made, guidance from the Archdiocese will be sought, and recommendations will be offered to the Archbishop for his advice and approval.
