- TOUR OF THE GARLAND SCHOOL: Parents may come for a short visit, to look at the school and outdoor environment. During this time, your host can meet you and your child, and answer any questions you may have at this time. You will also receive an informational packet, and preliminary application paperwork. If interested, parents may also request an appointment to observe the classroom quietly for a half hour, but it is important that the children's routine and play are not disrupted. The teacher will give you some 'meaningful work' to do as you observe.
- **TEACHER INTERVIEW**: Your application will be given to the teacher of the program to which you are applying. A teacher will contact you for a time to meet with you and your child, assess developmental needs, gather biographical information, and to answer questions.
- **ENROLLMENT**: After you have received a letter of acceptance, you must send in enrollment form and a \$400 enrollment deposit, which is nonrefundable, to hold a place for your child. This deposit will be applied toward your tuition costs. Enrollment forms and deposit are due by June 1st for September enrollment.
- TUITION ASSISTANCE: If you are a family in need, please ask us for an application for tuition assistance. For Vermont residents, you must apply first for State Childcare Subsidy through the Winston Prouty Center:802-257-7852 or go to http://dcf.vermont.gov/cdd/forms ccfap
- **VOLUNTEERING and FUNDRAISING**: Tuition alone cannot support the costs of The Garland School. We ask each family to support the school with volunteer work such as participation in committees; Fundraising, Community Support, Festivals, and Class Parent.
