DR. EMMI PIKLER WAS A HUNGARIAN PEDIATRICIAN, WHO IN 1946, TOOK OVER THE RUNNING OF AN ORPHANAGE IN BUDAPEST. HER PIONEERING WORK OF CARING FOR YOUNG CHILDREN WAS CONTINUED HERE IN THE USA UNDER THE GUIDANCE OF MAGDA GERBER (THE RIE INSTITUTE). ELEMENTS OF THIS RESPECTFUL APPROACH TO CHILDCARE INCLUDE: UNHURRIED AND ATTENTIVE CAREGIVING, FREEDOM FOR THE CHILD TO MOVE ON HIS OWN, ALLOWING THE CHILD TO MAKE USE OF HER FULL CAPACITIES, AND AN INTENTIONAL ENVIRONMENT THAT ALLOWS FOR SELF-INITIATED EXPLORATION.

TERESA SAVEL IS A MENTOR FOR TEACHERS AND PARENTS IN THE PRACTICES OF EMMI PIKLER. SHE FOUNDED THE GREEN VALLEY SCHOOL IN PUTNEY, WHICH GAVE RISE TO THE GARLAND SCHOOL IN BRATTLEBORO EIGHT YEARS AGO.
