#### Note from Mrs. B -

I want to thank all parents for contributing to their child's Halloween party! The parties were wonderful and the children had a great time! As the holiday season approaches we will be combining projects and activities that touch on concepts of what Thanksgiving is all about and what it means to be thankful. We will explore with our five senses and further investigate what hibernation means for the animals in the environment as they prepare for the cold weather.

Winter fun and holidays around the world will help support the children's learning of what other boys and girls their age celebrate where they live. I will also be incorporating math concepts of basic shapes, one to one correspondence, and number recognition for numbers 1-10 in the 3 year class. We will build on these concepts in the 4 year class by extending numbers to 20. Zoo phonics letters and characters will continue in the 4 year class as the children will soon be creating their own alphabet book that they will work on throughout the year. Also the alphabet bags and activities will be a great part of useful practice of letter identification and sounds as well. In the 4 year classes I will also be introducing the Mystery Bag and Traveling bear bags that the kids will rotate and take home. The kids love to share fun stories and solve mysteries during the second circle time with their friends !!

This month we will also be practicing for the Winter concert that will take place on December 13th. I will pass out the song lyrics so you too can help your child practice at home. Please take a look at the songs:

4 year class: Rudolph the Red Nose Reindeer and We wish you a Merry Christmas and Happy New Year

#### Payment Reminder

- All tuition payments must be made by using Zelle, check or money order. NO CASH!

- At this time, we are only using Zelle for tuition payments. All fundraising and field trips need to be paid with check or money order.
- Please include your child's name and what the payment is for on the memo line (e.g. Jane Smith Registration Fee).

#### **Tuition Reminder**

- Tuition is due on the first of every month, and is paid a month in advance (e.g. November's tuition is due on October 1st).
- Please include your child's name and the month in which you are paying (e.g. John Smith November Tuition) on the memo line of your check or money order and place your payment in the tuition payment box located below the parent board in the classroom. Alternatively, you can mail your payment directly to the school (Attn: Treasurer).
- If tuition is not paid by the 10th of the month, a \$10 late fee will be assessed.

### Note from Health and Records -

#### Healthy Eating Heading into the Holiday Season:

Having a hard time getting your little one to eat his or her vegetables and fruit? Here are a few tips taken from <u>www.pbs.org</u> on how to get your kids to chow down on healthier choices, especially during the holiday season.

- 1. **Get them involved:** If you involve kids in planning meals, going grocery shopping, and preparing food, they will become invested in the process and more likely to eat.
- 2. **Go to the source:** Teach kids where their food comes from. Head to the local farmer's market and meet people who grow food. Try picking berries from a vine or visiting a local dairy farmer. Grow your own tomatoes in the spring.
- 3. **Make healthy snacks available (even on the run):** If you stock the kitchen (or car) exclusively with healthy treats, children will eat them. As your children grow, stock good snacks in cabinets and shelves that they can reach.
- 4. **Be a role model:** Letting your child see you make healthy food choices may encourage him or her to do the same.
- 5. **Don't give up:** Most children need multiple exposures (between 5 and 10) to try new foods. Even if a child rejects a food the first couple times, offer it again!
