



#### National Physical Fitness and Sports Month

May is a wonderful time to raise awareness about the benefits of physical activity, and what better time than with our warmer weather to get outside. Regular physical activity is good for everyone's health for people of all ages. In children, physical activity can improve muscular fitness, bone health, and heart health. Along with healthy eating, physical activity can help prevent heart disease, cancer, and stroke.

Sixty minutes is the recommended amount of moderate to vigorous activity for children to see healthy weight benefits as an adult. Have your family make small changes, like taking a walk after dinner or going for a bike ride. Below are a few activities to get started on a healthy path. Remember to use proper safety equipment depending on the activities you select.

- Give children toys that encourage physical activity like balls, kites, and jump ropes.
- Encourage children to join a sports team or try a new physical activity.
- Take that stairs instead of the elevator.
- Find time to spend together doing a fun activity: family park day, swim day, or bike day.


