#### **Payment Reminder**

### Healthy Eating Heading into the Holiday Season:

Having a hard time getting your little one to eat his or her vegetables and fruit? Here are a few tips taken from <a href="https://www.pbs.org">www.pbs.org</a> on how to get your kids to chow down on healthier choices, especially during the holiday season.

- Get them involved: If you involve kids in planning meals, going grocery shopping, and preparing food, they will become invested in the process and more likely to eat.
- Go to the source: Teach kids where their food comes from. Head to the local farmer's market and meet people who grow food. Try picking berries from a vine or visiting a local dairy farmer. Grow your own tomatoes in the spring.
- Make healthy snacks available (even on the run): If you stock the kitchen (or car) exclusively with healthy treats, children will eat them. As your children grow, stock good snacks in cabinets and shelves that they can reach.
- 4. **Be a role model:** Letting your child see you make healthy food choices may encourage him or her to do the same.
- 5. Don't give up: Most children need multiple exposures (between 5 and 10) to try new foods. Even if a child rejects a food the first couple times, offer it again!
