

## **Student Leadership Clinics LLC - Scholarships**

### **TIMING**

The Student Leadership Clinics LLC ("Scholarship Contest") begins at 12:01:00 a.m. Pacific Standard Time ("ET"), April 1, 2012, and ends at 11:59:59 p.m. Pacific Time, Friday, June 15, 2012 ("Contest Entry Period"). Essays postmarked, or e-mailed, after Friday, June 15, 2012, will not be considered.

### **SPONSOR.**

### **ELIGIBILITY.**

The Scholarship Contest is open to legal residents of the United States and Canada, including the District of Columbia, but excluding Puerto Rico and the Province of Quebec, 13 years of age or older at the time of entry who are attending a high school or college.
