F and G were added about September. 1862, September. 1863, and October. 1864, respectively. It was also known as Adrian's Battalion Partisan Rangers and as Phipps' Battalion Tennessee Cavairy. Companies B and E of this battalion served from December, 1862, to about June. 1863, in a temporary field organization known as Hardy's Squadron Tennessee Cavairy, and acted as escort to Maj. Gen. McCown. The 12th and the 16th Battalions Tennessee Cavairy served from about June, 1863, to March. 1894, in a temporary field organization called the 1st Tennessee Legion and Rucker's Legion Tennessee
Cavalry, but were mustered separately.
