Will of Jas. Harvey King:

In the name of God Amen. I James Harvey King being of sound mind and disposing memory, calling to mind the uncertainty of life and the certainty of death and being desirous to dispose of and settle all my worldly business as far as practicable do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form as follows:

1st It is my will that all my just debts be paid out of the proceeds of my personal estate.

2nd It is my will that my youngest son, Samuel G. King have all my land with the appurtenances thereunto belonging and that he pay to my other three sons four hundred dollars each the first payment to be made in two years after my decease and one hundred dollars annually until the said sum of four hundred dollars is paid up to each of my three sons (to wit) James G. King, Thomas King & John L. King.

3rd It is my will that each one of my sons above named shall pay to my four daughters one hundred dollars in two [years] after my death (to wit) Elianor A. Cox, Rachel G. Agy, Susan S. Parker & Julia A. King making \$100 to each one.

4th It is my will that whatever may be left of the proceeds of my personal estate after paying all my just debts and funeral expenses shall be divided among my four daughters above named, share and share alike.

5th It is my will that my grand son James B. King have my watch.

6th I hereby constitute and appoint my son John S. King my Executor to carry out the provisions of this my last will and testament. In Testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal this 9th day of December 1861.
