AGED FARMER DIES IN HIGHLAND PARK

**J. B. Sizemore, 68, Passes
Away at the Home of
His Son, M. C. Sizemore**

J. B. Sizemore, 68, farmer, died at the home of his son, M. C. Sizemore, in Highland Park this morning at 2:00 o'clock, following a brief illness. His body will be taken by motor to the old home at Edison, Tenn., tomorrow morning where funeral services will be conducted from the Compromise church at 10:00 o'clock with Rev. Johnson of that town in charge. Interment will be made in the Edison cemetery.

He had been a resident of this city for four years and was a member of the Baptist Church.

Mr. Sizemore is survived by two boys, M. C. and Elmer of Kingsport, and Pennington Gap, Va.; five daughters, Mrs. E. C. Hobbs, Kingsport; Mrs. C. D. Holt, Pennington Gap, Va.; Mrs. John M. Pearson, Edison, Tenn.; Mrs. P. K. Peterson, Duffield, Va., and Mrs. T. P.
