Lucy married her cousin, Charles Allen. Charles Allen's parents were Joseph & Elizabeth Allen and Lucy was the daughter of Joseph's sister Mary Allen Bacon.

Lucy's husband, Charles Allen died in 1777 and she must have remarried because her will lists her as Lucy Smith.

A copy of her will from the South Carolina Archives follows where she lists as a beneficiary her son "Charles Allen".

## WILL OF

LUCY SMITH

So Carolina=)

In the name of God. Amen=

Laurens District )

I Lucy Smith of the place aforesaid being weak of body, but of sound and perfect mind and memory and knowing there is a time appointed for all men to die

I do hereby make and ordain this my last will and testament and do hereby revoke and make null and void all former will or wills by me previously made and acknowledge this only as my last will etc.

And after bequeathing my Soul to God who gave it and my body to be decently buried, at the discretion of my Executor hereafter appointed-

I do hereby give and bequeath to my Son Charles Allen the following property (VIZ) my negro man Allick my negro boy Andrew and my negroe boy Allen also all my money I have out on Intrust, all my Claim of money due me in Virginia and what I may have on hand at my disease all my stock of Horses, Cattle Hogs & other Stock of any kind all my working tools-Household and kitchen furniture corn wheat- meat and Every kind of provisions forage etc. etc. Except such things as hereafter will do to others and that the sd Charles pay out of the above Legesseye as follows (Viz) To Salley Atkins Daughter of Lydall Allen - one Hundred Dollars & one Cow for the use of Schooling her Children and to pay Frances and Cynthia Allen Daughter of the sd Lydall, fifty Dollars Each as soon as convenient after my Disease 2ndly I give to my grandson Joel Allen my negro man Jim and my negroe boy George and the tract of land whereon I now live--

I hereby give my Daughter Sarah McNeese fifty Dollars and my Daughter Mary Harris twenty Dollars if my money due me in Virginia is Ever Collected-

I give to my grand Daughter Sarah Crisp my negroe woman AGGY and her future Increase and to her Daughter Lucy Crisp one feather bed and furniture--

I give to Milley Allen widow of Lydall Allen one cow & calf-

I give my grand Daughter Lucy Bacon Allen my negroe

And I hereby appoint My Son Charles Allen my Sole Executor  
to Carrey into Effect Every part and article of this My last
