Samuel Dodson SR, presumably a son of John Dodson, first appears in records on the 1789 tax list of Montgomery County, VA assessed for 1 white poll and 2 horses. His date and place of birth is not determined, nor is the name of his wife known. He apparently died in Grainger County, TN possibly between 1806 and 1810. Deducting from the age of his son Samuel we can judge that he was born during the early 1750's. The last record of him is his name signed to a petition in 1806 Grainger County seeking improvements of the KY Road. He is not listed in the 1810 census or tax list in Grainger County.

Samuel was a landowner in the area now Grayson and Carroll Counties, VA as early as 1790 and prob earlier.

The records of Grayson County VA and Grainger County TN offer the suggestion that Samuel had the following children:

*Samuel Dodson, Jr, Vollentine Dodson, Thomas Dodson and Sarah (perhaps John)
