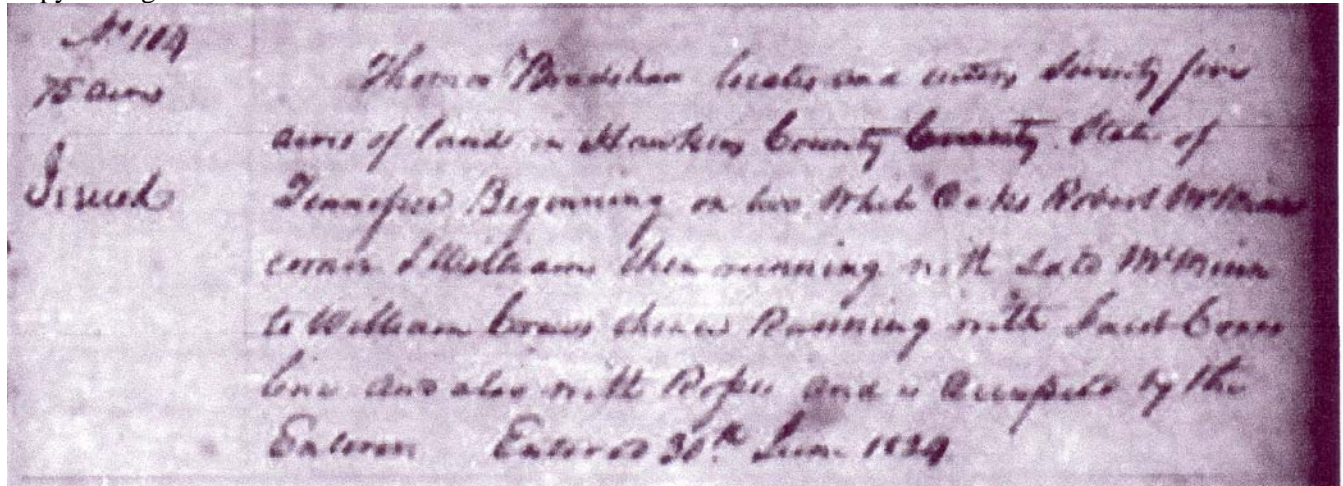

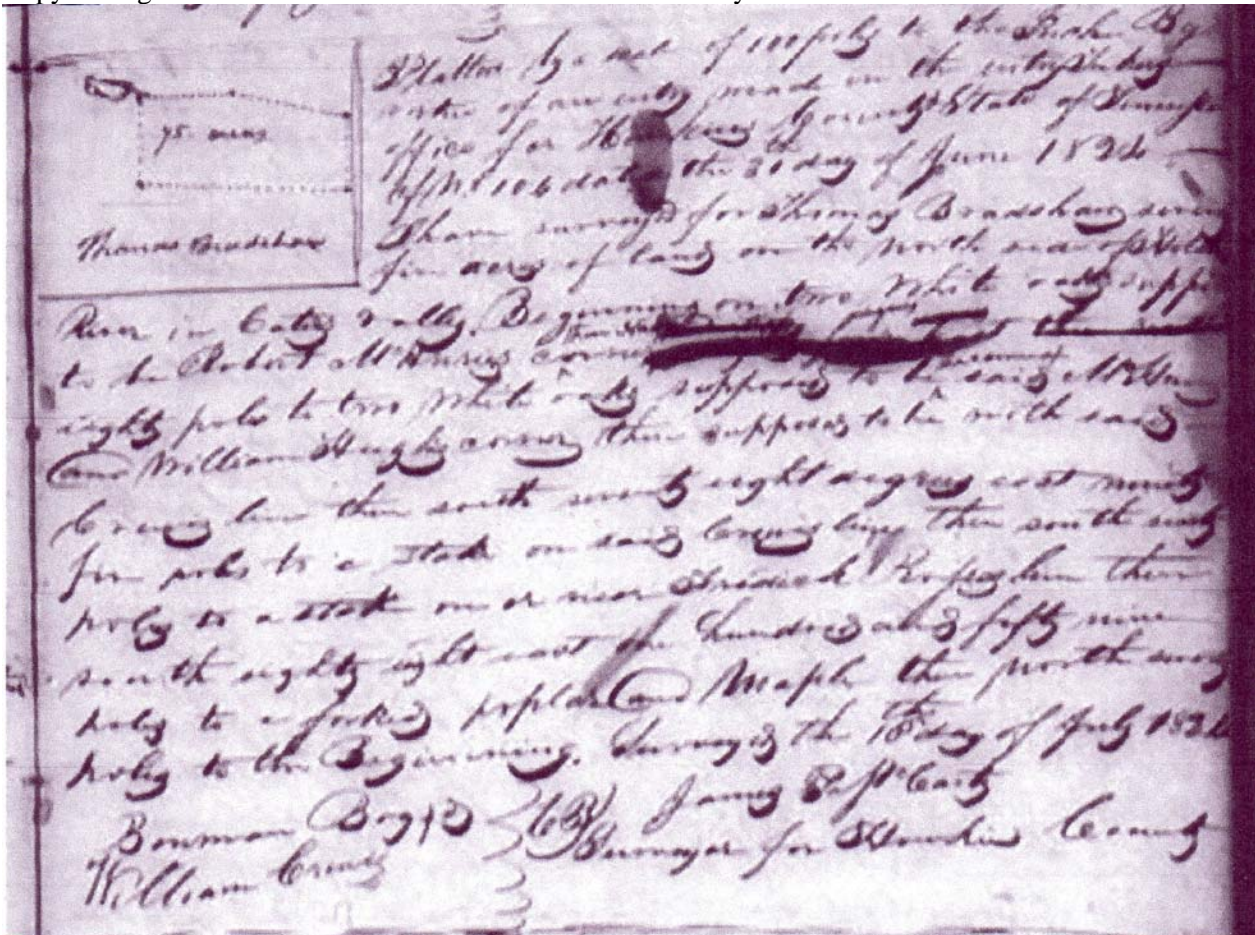

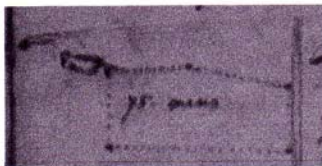

By virtue of an entry made in the entry Takers office for Hawkins County & State of Tennessee of No. 104 dated the 30th day of June 1824 ~ I have surveyed for Thomas Bradshaw seven five acres of land on the north side of Holstein River in Caters valley. Beginning on two white

oaks suppose to be Robert McHenries corner then North (scratched out and unreadable) eighty poles to two white oaks suppose to be the corner of said McHenries and William Hugh's corner then supposed to be with said Crew's line then south seventy eight degrees east ninety five poles to a stake on said Crew's line then south sixty poles to a stake on or near Frederick Rosses line then south eighty eight east one hundred and fifty nine poles to a forked poplar and maple then north seventy poles to the Beginning. Surveyed the 16th day of July 1824
