Thomas Livesey of Feniscowles, (a son of *John Livesey*), died in **1597**. He left a will in which he says - "To my eldest son John, if he marry, 6 silver spoons, and all the glass about the house in every chamber and window, and one great fire iron standing in the chimney of my house, one pair of plow irons, three standing bed stocks, three wheel bed stocks, and one long sideboard in the side of the house and the form standing by it, also a pair of iron raches, all sheets as heirlooms so that he will have them again as heirlooms a Ffeniscowles. - I constitute, ordain, and make *Alice Livesey*, my wife, and *Thomas Livesey*, my son, my executors." He also mentions his brothers *Randle Livesey* and *Richard Livesey*. Certain lands at Feniscowles belonged to his brother *Randle*. *Alice*, widow of *Thomas Livesey* was buried **7 August 1623**. *John Livesey* de Feniscowles, like his father died young, his burial took place **26 July 1626**. He left a son, *Thomas* and a daughter, *Alice*. This next *Thomas*, son of the late *John*, had three sons, *Thomas* baptized **29 September 1640**, *John* and *Christopher*. *Thomas* died before his father.
