Thomas Livesey of Feniscowles, (a son of John Livesey), died in 1597. He left a will in which he says - "To my eldest son John, if he marry, 6 silver spoons, and all the glass about the house in every chamber and window, and one great fire iron standing in the chimney of my house, one pair of plow irons, three standing bed stocks, three wheel bed stocks, and one long sideboard in the side of the house and the form standing by it, also a pair of iron raches, all sheets as heirlooms so that he will have them again as heirlooms a Ffeniscowles. - I constitute, ordain, and make Alice Livesey, my wife, and Thomas Livesey, my son, my executors." He also mentions his brothers Randle Livesey and Richard Livesey. Certain lands at Feniscowles belonged to his brother Randle. Alice, widow of Thomas Livesey was buried 7 August 1623. John Livesey de Feniscowles, like his father died young, his burial took place 26 July 1626. He left a son, Thomas and a daughter, Alice. This next Thomas, son of the late John, had three sons, Thomas baptized 29 September 1640, John and Christopher. Thomas died before his father.
