BIOGRAPHY: Thomas was a married taxable in 1783. In 1784 he had a family of 4. He likely moved to the Warriors Mark area of Huntingdon County about 1785. Here he died in 1820. The 1790 census figures are 1 2 4....

In 1788 William Weston, single, was living with or near his brother Thomas.

Thomas and George were listed as eligible for militia duty in the newly-formed Huntingdon County in 1788....

According to his grandson, Thomas Weston Stephens, Thomas Weston lived at the foot of the mountain. He was large and strong, weighing 240 pounds. The Westons were ardent Methodists.

Huntingdon Circuit was formed in 1788. James Reiley, the preacher in 1814, wrote of his pleasant recollections of the Weston family. In 1844 Birmingham Circuit was formed from Huntingdon. In 1849 Thomas Weston (Jr) was recording steward and classleader. There were 23 in the class which met at Weston's Mills.
