

Dau: Ruth Bedon. Granddaus: Jane Wilkins; Ruth Meverick, under 18 years; Elizabeth Bedon; daus. of my sons Robert and Daniel. Cousin: Robert Rivers' children Robert and Francis. Will of George Rivers, Sr. follows. It is evident from this will that his son, George Rivers, Jr., had married and moved away since he leaves his son property and land but only on the condition his son returns within 2 years of his death. The reason for these stipulations is unknown.

IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN, I George Sivers of James Inland St intress Province of South Caroline Planter being week in Redy but of Sound & Porfect Mind & Messary themine be to Almighty God for the sense but Considering the uncertainty of this Transitory itte De make Publish and Declare these presents to be & Contain w last will & Testement bereby 'evoking and makeing mull and wid all fermer wills by me heretefere made and Published & first being hartily orry for all my Sine Past I Conmit my Soul min Almighty God by Creator trusting by his Infinite Marcy & by the Mritts of my Blefsed Saviour Jesus Christ to have full afree Rendfoom of all my Sine & my body I Commit to the Sarth te be becoming intered according to the Discretion of my keestrix & Exters hereafter maned my Will is that all my Just Debts and funeral Expendes be first Paid & Discharged. Emprisde. Item- I do give & bequeath unto my Son Thomas ivers fifty Acres of lead whereon he now Lives and being in his Persersion together with the Island Called and known by the name of helf Tide Island to him and his Heirs forever. Item. I do give & bequesth unto my on ob-. Stress one hundred Acres of Land therees he now lives and to his Heirs Lawfully Begottem of his hely forever. Item. I do give and Bequeath unto my Sen George Rivers one hundred Acres of Land bounding to the weatward on lead of Beary Sammays & .ilkins and to the actward on the aferencia hundred acres given to by Son Robert. My will further is that in Case my Son George Rivers shald not Return here in two Years after my Decease them my will & Desire is that my langhter Buth Bedon shall have the use use & Imprevements of Twenty Acres of Land, Taken out of the aforemaid Hundred Acres left to my Son Scorge During her Natural Life and no Longer, & then the aforesaid One hundred tores Land to be Equally divided meng my Some them Jurvivings & to their Heirs forever. Item. I do give & bequeath unto my Son Daniel Rivers all that my Tract of land where now he Liveth Extending to the Westward as far as due my Gate Peats new stands in the feace that use from Mard to have Crafs the Book & to him & his heirs forever. Item.

I do give & Bequeath unto my Son John Rivers all that my Plantstics or Treat of Land where on I now Live Bounding to the E etwerd on the Lands given my Som Demiel Pivers & to the westward on my See Thomas Rivers Land, together with all the Buildings became built or hereafter to be built with the Deall Estande leter to the Eastward of the Half tide Island to his & his Heirs prever. Item. I give a Bequeath unto my Don Thomas ivers & Ms Beirs forever one Mustee Men Slave by mame Robin. Item. I give & bequeath unite my Don Robert Pivers & his heirs forever ten Men Thves By name Compson & Simon Item. I dive & Becoath unto my on Coorge Rivers & his heirs forever, One Negro an Slave by name cipic In Jase my Son Scorge eturns here in ten Years efter my coease, if not them my will and order is that the aforesaid Mogra shall be iqually divided emong my Jonsh the Serviving. Item. I give & bequeath meto my Son John Tivers this Heirs forever one megro man Slave by name "am & one Mantee Teman Clave by name Moll & all her Mail Children that shall be living at my Decease. Item. I give & bequeath unto my Gramimphter Jame "ilbins one negro girl slave by mame Lindey. Item. I give & bequeath unto my Grandaughter Ruth Meverick one negro Girl slave by name Hagar " gether with one hundred Founds Curmet money of this Province. I will & order the the aforemid One Hundred Founds be by my Amors put out to Interest on med security for a portion for my randaughter with Maverick & that She receive the Came at the age of Sighteen or/the Day of buriage together with the negro Girl Hager above mentioned. Bus if she my aferesaid randaughter happen to Die before she arrive to that age or Day of marriage them I order the said Maney & Mare Girl to be squally Divided and shared among my Sons then beriving. Item. I give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Ruth Bedon ther heirs one megro men Slave by name Jack. Item. I give & bequeath unto my Son John livers & his Heirs all my Household Goods & furniture that is to say that shall remain & to be found in my belling house at my eccase. Item. I will order & direct that efter all my Jant Debts & Legacies be paid by my or ere my will a order is that all the Remainder of my Personal Estate heretofore Mapped of Shall be by my Extern Equally Divided into Six lar Six Children hereafter hereafter memod, that is b

my Sen Thomas Rivers, my Son Robert Rivers, my Son Daniel livers my Son John Rivers my Daughter Ruth Bedon & my Son George livers that is to say In case my Son George Returns here in two years after my Decease & if not my will & order is that my Son Seerge's Part or Division to be Equally Divided by my Exfers between my five Children (Vizt)/Robert, Daniel John Ruth if then all Living , if not among the then Survivors. I Constitute Mominate & appoint my well Beleved Sons Thomas Rivers Robert Rivers Daniel Rivers & John Sivers Exers & trustees of this my last Will & Testament Ra ifying & Confirming this & no other to be my Last Will & Testament h Witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand & Seal this Elevmth Day of July in the Year of our Lard God One thousand Seven hadred and forty nine. 1349.
