14 Sept. 1833. Met in conference and after a discourse by Brother BOWERS, we proceeded to business. Brother ROBERTS and Sister PELLUM are no longer members of our church. Brother JAMES BOWERS on confession of his repentance is restored into full fellowship again. Opened a door for experience and RECHAEL DAVIS, REBECCA DUBERLY, ISAAC B. MASON and JAMES FREEMAN came forward with satisfactory experiences and appointed to be baptised tomorrow. Dismissed.
