In name of God Amen,

I Martin Kitzmiller Senr. being of Sound mind and disposing memory Knowing the certainty of death after Commending my Soul to God who gave it; Dispose of my worldly affects in the following manner (to wit) after paying all my Just debts my son David has received his part of my estate also my Son John has got his part, and likewise my Son Martin and his heirs has got their part my Daughter Elizabeth Devault is to pay my Son Henrys heirs five hundred dollars in one year after my decease or Sooner if She Can. My daughter Mary Hodges has got her part of my estate, also my Daughter Elizabeth Devault is to have all the household and Kitchen furniture together with tools and farming utensils at my Decease and everything that is in the house all money due me at my death is to be equally Divided between my Son John Mary Hodges Elizabeth Devault and my Son Henrys Heirs in Testimony hereof I have Set my hand and affixed my Seal this 10th day of March 1859. Lastly I appoint my Son John Kitzmiller and my Grandson Valentine Devault my Executors

My daughter Mary Hodges has got her part of my estate also my Daughter Elizabeth Devault is to have all the household and Kitchen furniture together with tools and farming utensils at my decease and every thing that is in the house at my decease and my estate is to be equally divided between my sons John Mary Hodges Elizabeth Devault and my son George being in testimony hereof I have set my hand and affixed my Seal this 10th day of March 1859. Lastly I appoint my son John Kitchmill and my grandson Calista Devault my Executors
