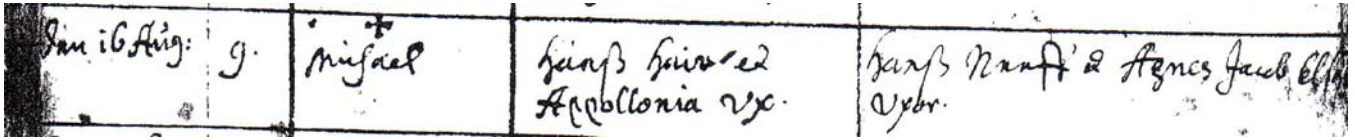

5. MICHEL HAIR, second child and oldest son of Hans ("Küechhans") Hair and his first wife, Apollonia Rath, was born at Pfalzgrafenweiler, 16 August 1669, and d there, 8 March 1729. He was buried on 10 March 1729. For many years he was a church convent judge and senator at Pfalzgrafenweiler. He married there, on 24 February 1691, BARBARA HACK, who was born at Pfalzgrafenweiler, 28 May 1669, and died there, 13 February (buried 14 February) 1735. She was daughter of Burckhardt Hack, possibly a native of Altensteig, who died on 6 May 1703, perhaps at Pfalzgrafenweiler, and his wife, Maria, daughter of Michel Rienhardt. (See TABLE OF ANCESTORS, Generation 4, numbers 10 and 11.) Michel and Barbara (Hack) Hair had the following children: (*all born at Pfalzgrafenweiler*)

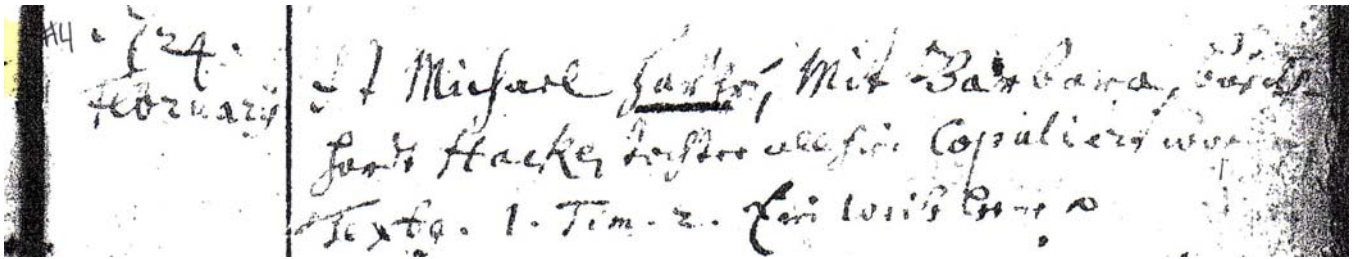

The marriage between Michael Hayhr and Barbara Hack (daughter of Burckhardt Hack in Pfalzgrafenweiler) has been performed on 24 Feb. 1691 in Pfalzgrafenweiler.

Michael Hayer, alderman and for many years member of the moral supervision court, died on 8 Mar 1729 in Pfalzgrafenweiler, aged 60 years less 5 months, and was buried on 10 Mar.

Note:

According to Genealogist, Friedrich Wollmershauser, a senator was someone who was a member of a local court which judged minor crimes and a church convent judge was someone who investigated moral crimes (pregnancy before marriage, working on Sunday, etc)
