I do not have much information on Richard Potter other than that he was the father of Thomas Potter and according to "The Parish Church of Saint Mary the Virgin" of Westerham, booklet, pg 14, there is an effigy of him there.

5 Richard Potter (d. 1563): the inscription shows he had three wives, Elizabeth, Anne and Alice; had 20 children of whom three sons and 10 daughters were living at his death in 1563. This brass is a palimpsest or old Flemish plate, with an older design on the reverse.
