

FALL ACTIVITIES IN THE GARDEN

- SEPTEMBER IS A GOOD MONTH FOR PLANTING PERENNIALS, TREES AND SHRUBS
- OCTOBER IS STILL GOOD FOR PLANTING TREES AND SHRUBS
- PLANT BULBS IN OCTOBER
- REMOVE DEAD ANNUALS
- CUT BACK MESSY PERENNIALS
- LIME IN OCTOBER
- LEAVE ORNAMENTAL GRASSES AND PERENNIALS WITH SEED HEADS THROUGH WINTER
- AFTER CLEAN-UP APPLY 1" OF COMPOST
- MOW THE LEAVES ON YOUR LAWN, AND LEAVE THE SHREDDED LEAVES TO COMPOST ON YOUR LAWN
- FERTILIZE WITH 10:10:10 AFTER THE LEAVES HAVE FALLEN
- WATER ALL NEW PLANTINGS UNTIL THE SOIL IS FROZEN
- ROSES AND OTHER TENDER PLANTS NEED TO BE MULCHED AFTER THE SOIL IS FROZEN
