Reminders

Before and After School Care Only

We will match any competitor rates for Rogus Kindergarten before and after school care. You must show us a price sheet from the competitor (example: Park District, Ivy League, KinderCare, etc.) (No in-home service.) Services must be comparable. The rate is under the discretion of the director. We provide small size activities, snack, and homework time. We do have a bus stop for Walker School for 5^{th} and 6th grade before and after school care.
