The type of leader you are is determined by the decisions you make. Whatever attribute influences your decisions have decided what type of leader you are in that **MOMENT**.

## **20 TYPES OF LEADERS**

- INSPIRATIONAL LEADERS: These types of leaders lead by what inspires them.
- STRATEGIC LEADERS: These types of leaders do not do anything without a reason. These people are natural planners.
- **INNOVATIVE LEADERS**: These types of leaders are trailblazers. They blaze a path where there is none. They

are truly misunderstood and have complicated personalities.

- **THOUGHT LEADERS**: These people lead with their perspectives and perceptions. They inspire people to see things differently by stimulating their mind with fresh ideas.
- EXPERIENCED LEADERS: These people rely on past experiences and past knowledge to make current decisions. Their experience guides their actions.
- EMOTIONAL LEADERS: These types of leaders make decisions based on how they feel at the current moment. The moment is more important than the future for these leaders.
- CHARISMATIC LEADERS: These types of leaders lead by what is appealing, fascinating or glamorous to them. These people inspire you with fancy words, not substance.

• NATURAL BORN LEADERS: These types of leaders make decisions based on divine insight from God.

 INTELLECTUAL LEADERS: These types of leaders rely on numbers and analytics to make their decisions.
Everything is predicted on logic, not feeling.

 FEARFUL LEADERS: leaders who make decisions based on what they fear play it safe because they are afraid to take risks.

 INSTINCTIVE LEADERS: These leaders make decisions based on their senses such as touch, taste, hear, feel and see. They anticipate what is coming ahead so they can prepare for it.

• WISE LEADERS: Leaders who are wise make decisions based on divine Kingdom laws, not intellect.

 PROGRESSIVE LEADERS: Progressive leaders make things happen. They are agents of change.

- VISIONARY LEADERS: These types of leaders make decisions based on what they imagine in their mind. The pictures they see in their head are the things they move toward.
- INSECURE LEADERS: Insecure leaders are people who lead with pride because their arrogance disguises their lack of ability. Prideful people are quick to give instruction while rejecting correction.
- **DEMONSTRATIVE LEADERS**: These types of people lead by example and allow their actions to speak louder than their words.
- AGGRESSIVE LEADERS: People who are inpatient, pushy and demanding are aggressive leaders. These types of leaders put unnecessary pressure on you by expecting everything to be done immediately.
- **PATIENT LEADERS**: Patient leaders are not quick to move in action. They value moving in the right time.

Timing is more important than finishing to these types of leaders.

 OPTIMISTIC LEADERS: These types of leaders always expect a positive outcome from everything they do.
They always see the bright side of a rainy day. They never lose hope nor do they give up.

 STRONG LEADERS: Strong leaders carry the responsibilities of their followers time of weakness.

What type of leader are you? If you see that your leadership style is **NOT** effective then adopt another style that is effective. The list above is a reference for you to become the best person you can be.

Depending on where you are in life, **DIFFERENT** styles work at **DIFFERENT** times. There may be moments you need to be an aggressive leader. You may be in situations that requires you to become a patient leader. It is good to embody **ALL** styles of leadership so you can make a difference **ALL** the time.

The Apostle Paul said it best. 1st Corinthians 9:19-23 says, "For though I be free from all men, yet have I made myself servant unto all, that I might gain the more.
