

GOD'S WORD SHOULD NEVER BE INTERPRETED

(John 12:49)

When a person **INTERPRETS** the Word of God they are adding their opinion to God's truth. This is dangerous. If a person adds their flawed and limited opinion to God's **FLAWLESS** truth the message will lose its potency. We should **NEVER** interpret God's Word. Here's why.

- Revelation 22:19 says, "*And if anyone **TAKES AWAY** from the words of this book of prophecy, God will take away that one's share of the tree of life and of the holy city, which are written about in this book.*"
- Deuteronomy 4:2 says, "***DON'T ADD** to these commands, and do not leave anything out, but obey the commands of the Lord your God that I give you.*"

- Proverbs 30:6 says "**DO NOT ADD** to his words, or he will correct you and prove you are a liar."

When a person interprets the Word of God they are either adding to what God said or taking away from what He said. When you hear an individual teaching the Bible they should **NOT** provide their opinions and personal ideas. They should **ONLY** communicate what they hear from the Holy Spirit.

THE BIBLE IS MEANT TO BE ECHOED,
NOT INTERPRETED.

Jesus is the Son of God. He is the Christ. He is the Anointed One. He is the chosen one. Jesus didn't interpret the Bible. Jesus said the words He heard His Father speak. John 12:49 says, "*The things I taught were **NOT** from myself. The Father who sent me **TOLD ME WHAT TO SAY AND WHAT TO TEACH.***"

Jesus could of spoken His own words. He had the right to add His own opinion. Jesus spoke what He heard from His Father, not how he felt. He understood that the words of God were meant to be echoed, not interpreted. If Jesus followed this blueprint so should you. Every preacher in the world should **ONLY** speak the words that are **INSPIRED** by the Holy Spirit when they are teaching the Bible.

Do not let people deceive into thinking that God's Word should be interpreted. This is a lie. The Word of God is **NEVER** up for interpretation. It is **NOT** your responsibility to take God's Word and add your twist to it. It is the Holy Spirit's responsibility to teach us the Word of God so we can share that **SAME** message with our neighbor.

CAN I TEACH THE BIBLE WITHOUT THE HOLY SPIRIT?

Yes, you can teach the Bible without the Holy Spirit.

However, your teaching will be **INACCURATE**. If a person is teaching the Bible **WITHOUT** the power of the Holy Spirit they will mislead you. Unfortunately, many religions have taken bits and pieces of the Bible and created their own religion.

When people do this they are **EXCLUDING** themselves from entering the Holy city according to Revelation 22:19. Beware of spiritual leaders who preach the Bible yet, ignorant of the Holy Spirit. If a spiritual leader is ignorant of the Holy Spirit you must question where his information came from?

If a preacher does not know how to hear the Holy Spirit where is he getting his insight from? If a preacher does not have a relationship with the Holy Spirit where is he getting his revelation from?

If your knowledge is not given to you by the Holy Spirit, your intellect is interpreting the Word of God. Never listen to a preacher who teaches the Bible with His intellect. Many people have been deceived because they've listened to people who articulated the Bible void of power. When a person interprets the Bible they will never **MATERIALIZE** the promises, blessings, miracles, signs and wonders the Bible tells us about.

When a person teaches under the guidance of the Holy Spirit they will know how to extract power from God's Word. This was the difference between the Apostle Paul and the Pharisees. The Pharisees knew how to articulate God's Word. However, they did not know how to walk in spiritual authority. The Apostle Paul knew how to **MANIFEST** God's Word because he was led by the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

1st Corinthians 2:4 says, *"My teaching and preaching were not with words of human wisdom that persuade people but with the proof of the **POWER** that the **SPIRIT GIVES.**"*

DO NOT INTERPRET GOD'S WORD WITH YOUR INTELLECT. ECHO THE VOICE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT!
