Worldly success spoils you with materialism while leaving you **VOID** of spiritual authority. Worldly success will give you the power to change what is **AROUND** you. It will not give you the power to change what is **WITHIN YOU**. When you become the recipient of worldly success, you will live an abundant life while feeling empty.

Walking in spiritual authority will change everything around you while changing you in the process. Worldly success is centered around obtaining money, fame and popularity. There is nothing wrong with obtaining these things. **HOWEVER**, when you obtain these things, **VOID** of God, they will cause you tremendous harm.

Many people confuse worldly success with Godly success. God will grant you with materialistic items. However, these items do not define Godly success. The system of the world has contaminated the blessings of God with their lack of understanding.

Proverbs 3:5 says, "Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding." Matthew 4:8-9

#### WHAT IS GODLY SUCCESS?

1st Samuel 18:13-14
