SUBJECT: **Your dreams are not foolish. Not having a dream is foolish.**

I was afraid to tell people my dreams. I was afraid of their responses. I thought I would look and sound foolish if I told people the dreams God gave me. My fear prevented me from manifesting my dreams because I didn't want the criticism.

One day in my prayer time the Holy Spirit told me not to be ashamed of my dreams. I remember what He said to me. He said, "**MY DREAMS ARE NOT FOOLISH. NOT HAVING A DREAM IS FOOLISH.**" This was a wow moment for me. At that moment I started working on my dream.

I made a conscious effort to advertise my dream and manifest my dream. When I started moving toward my dream people criticized me. They made fun of me. They

spoke to me with sarcasm. They doubted my efforts. However, the words of the Holy Spirit strengthen me to be confident in spite of the attack.

DON'T let the negative chatter of people stop you from manifesting your dream. It doesn't matter how big your dream is, how weird it is or how impossible it may seem. If God gave you the dream it will come to pass. Joseph had the same problem.

God gave Joseph a major dream. He dreamt that he would rule over his brothers and they would bow down to him in reverence. When Joseph told his brothers about his dream they were consumed with jealousy.

Their jealousy led them to sell their brother into slavery. Even though Joseph was persecuted and harassed for embracing the dream God put in him, he never stop pursuing the dream. In time the dream came to pass.

Genesis 37 says, "*One time Joseph had a dream, and when he told his brothers about it, they hated him even more.*"

Believing the dream God put on your heart is smart. However, manifesting the dream is **WISE**. People who do not have a dream to manifest will chase empty wishes. Living without a dream to chase will rob you of your purpose.

People who do not have a dream to chase do not exhibit discipline. They work without a goal. They speak without cause. Not having a dream to chase is foolish because it will create a life of emptiness.

TAKEAWAY: When God gives you a dream don't let your fear stop you from manifesting it. When you stop working on your dream you will delay the manifestation.

Remember, the dream God gave you will **ALWAYS** come to pass. The **MORE** you work on it the faster it will manifest!
