The reason King Jesus went through the criticism that no other man could endure was because at one time the entire world was following Him. John 12:19 says, "So the Pharisees said to each other, "You can see that nothing is going right for us. Look! The whole world is following him."

TAKEAWAY: You will never escape being criticized. As your influence **INCREASES** so will your criticism. Thank God for the influence while asking Him for strength to endure the criticism.
