The people who became wealthy during the great depression were not special. They had vision. They **SAW** the God-given opportunity to buy property and land at a cheap price. The people who became rich during the explosion of crypto-currency were not special. They had vision.

They had the vision to **SEE** a God-given opportunity in the way we buy and sell items. In order to capitalize on every God-given opportunity, remember this law.

A MAN WITH A VISION

1st Samuel 17:25

Goliath was terrorizing Israel. Every person in Israel was afraid of Goliath except one man. Goliath was a ferocious adversary. He was big, strong, accomplished and fearless. He was a problem for the Israelite community. With all this being said, David, a young, skinny, poor brave boy wanted to approach this problem.

He **SAW** how Goliath was terrorizing his people's community. He **SAW** the fear on people's face when they spoke Goliath's name. David **SAW** a God-given opportunity. 1st Samuel 17:32 says, "*David said to Saul, "Don't let anyone be discouraged. I, your servant will go and fight this Philistine!"*"

The person who was able to kill the Philistine was going to be rewarded with a multitude of money, the king's daughter and the person's family will be free from paying taxes according to 1st Samuel 17:25. Remember, one God-given opportunity will open the door to many blessings.

David **WASN'T** looking for a fight. He stepped up to fight Goliath when he **SAW** the opportunity. If a God-given opportunity arrives, take advantage of it. You may **NOT** be ready for it. You may **NOT** be prepared for it.

Your may **NOT** have the resources to handle it. However, if you take advantage of a God-given opportunity in-spite of what you don't have **GOD WILL DO THE IMPOSSIBLE IF YOU DO WHAT IS POSSIBLE!**

David didn't have the equipment to fight Goliath. He didn't have the support. However, he had the **WISDOM** to take advantage of a God-given opportunity. When David did what was possible (walking by faith) God did what was impossible (defeating a giant).

Remember, when you deny God-given opportunities you will **DELAY** your purpose. When David capitalized on his opportunity, he inherited his purpose...becoming king of Israel. Wisdom Tip: **IF YOU STAY READY YOU WON'T HAVE TO GET READY.**
