I was given back my old position, and the baker was hanged. So the king called for Joseph. The guards quickly brought him out of the prison, and he shaved, put on clean clothes, and went before the king."

Sometimes God holds your destiny in the strangest places so you can trust Him and **NOT** your abilities. In the strangest places lies your treasure, purpose and blessing. **DO NOT** discard strange places. Everything that glitters is not gold and everything that is weird is **NOT** wrong.
