

UNITED ENEMIES

Psalms 83:1-18

United enemies are extremely dangerous. Enemies who unite with one another to attack you are powerful because their unity honors a Kingdom principle...**WHEN YOU ARE UNITED YOU CAN ACHIEVE ANYTHING.**

God honors His principles in-spite of who uses them. United enemies have one common goal...to **DESTROY** you. Enemies who unite with one another set their differences aside to accommodate a bigger agenda. Ecclesiastes 4:9 says, "*two people are better than one, because they get more done by working together.*"

When most people think of this scripture they correlate it with positivity. However, this same Kingdom principle can impact you negatively. The same Kingdom principle that can bless you is the **SAME** Kingdom principle that can

curse you. For instance, when a righteous man applies the principles of the Kingdom to his life he will **PROSPER**. However, if a evil man uses the principles of the Kingdom to **HURT** you, you will be hurt.

REALLY?

Genesis 11:4-6 says, *“Then, they said to each to other, “Let’s build a city and a tower for ourselves, whose top will reach high into the sky. We will become famous. Then we will not be scattered over all the earth.” The Lord came down to see the city and the tower that the people had built.*

*The Lord said, “Now, these people are united, all speaking the same language. This is only the beginning of what they will do. **THEY WILL BE ABLE TO DO ANYTHING THEY WANT.** Come, let us go down and confuse their language so they will not be able to understand each other.”*

These people were **NOT** loyal to God. They were His enemies. The all powerful God acknowledged the strength these united enemies possessed. God’s Word is

true. It works for people who are righteous and it works for people who are evil. Whoever **APPLIES** the Word of God will **SEE** results.

One righteous person **CANNOT DEFEAT TWO UNITED** enemies. Remember, two are better than one. However, two united righteous people **CAN** defeat united enemies. It is ideal to connect with another righteous person when you are being targeted by united enemies but sometimes it is difficult to find another righteous person to stand with you.

What do you do when you have to stand alone facing a lynch mob? What do you do when you cannot find another righteous person to walk with you? If you are forced to stand by yourself in the presence of multiple enemies **CALL** on King Jesus and repeat this prayer.

Psalms 83:1-18 shows us how God will respond to the prayers of those individuals who call on Him. You are too weak to fight united enemies alone. The **ONLY** way to

defeat united enemies is to have **TWO** righteous people stand in agreement with one another. Psalms 83 is a chapter you need to remember and keep on the tip of your tongue.

The enemy wants to destroy you and he will do whatever it takes to accomplish his goal. If he cannot destroy you with one person he will attempt to destroy you with two. Psalms 83 is a weapon to destroy the power of united enemies...**USE IT!**

YOUR WEAPON

*Psalms 83:1-18 says, "A song. A psalm of Asaph. God do not keep quiet; God, do not be silent or still. Your **ENEMIES** are making noises; those who hate you are getting ready to attack. They are making secret plans against your people; they plot against those you love.*

*They say, "Come, let's destroy them as a nation. Then no one will ever remember the name "Israel." They are **UNITED** in*

their plan. These have made an agreement against you: the families of Edom and the Ishmaelites, Moab and the Hagarites, the people of Byblos, Ammon, Amalek, Philistia, and Tyre.

Even Assyria has joined them to help Ammon and Moab, the descendants of Lot. God do to them what you did to Midian, what you did to Sisera and Jabin at the Kishon River. They died at Endor, and their bodies rotted on the ground. Do to their important leaders what you did to Oreb and Zeeb.

Do to their princes what you did to Zebah and Zalmunna. They said, "Let's take for ourselves the pasturelands that belong to God." My God, make them like tumbleweed, like chaff blown away by the wind. Be like a fire that burns a forest or like flames that blaze through the hills.

Chase them with your storm, and frighten them with your wind. Cover them with shame. Then people will look for you, Lord. Make them afraid and ashamed forever. Disgrace them and destroy them. Then they will know that you are the Lord, that only you are God Most High over all the earth."
