The images captured on a rainy day can be quite spectacular. Wear Comfortable water retardant clothing and protect your equipment. With plastic.

Avoid changing lenses in the rain use a telephoto lens or two camera bodies

Your equipment bag must be water proof and always carry a dry cloth to wipe the droplets from your lens. At the end of the day open up all of you cases and let them dry out completely.

A clear blue sky is very monopolist but add a few clouds, rain drops or snow flurries and your phot takes on an entirely new perspective,. The over cast shies diffuse the light and enhance the colours which make your image POP. They prove a softer light

.Rain puddles produce instant reflective areas with some imagination you can get than one in a lifetime shot.
