Aug 2017 Neutral Density Filters

Here are some simple techniques to help you get better landscape images directly from the camera and not spend hours processing them latter.

By using a Neutral Density and a Graduated Neutral Density filter allows for more artistic images That controls the exposure

The Neutral density Filter reduces the light entering the camera thus allowing for slower shutter speeds.

Typically the Neutral density filter is 1 stop lower but each filter is different and you will need to experiment with it to match your camera.

A graduated Neutral Density filter Is designed to affect only part of the image . Ideal for darkening the sky while leaving the ground at normal light.

For best results use the live view mode of your camera as the image is larger and better resolution than the view finder.

To eliminate camera shake and to help stabilize the camera use a tripod.

The screw on filter is Better than the Quick plate mount. Even though the cost is slightly more it is more durable and has a higher quality of glass

The neutral density filter is idea to shoot water falls in slow motion.

In conclusion the neutral density filter is a great companion to any photographer,s equipment bag which allows for more freedom of imagination and creativity. Have fun and experiment with the Neutral density and you might even surprise yourself with the results. **Training Courses**
