Summer fun

The key is to have fun. Carry the bare minimum of equipment to get the perfect shot but not too heavy to make your equipment a burden.

The bare minimum of equipment is a camera with a telephoto lens, fully charged batteries, a lens hood a polarizing filter and an 18% grey card.

Choose the lens most suited for the specific outing a good quality DSLR camera and a sturdy tripod.

Develop your photographic eye and learn to shoo from interesting angles . Look for magical shadows cast by various light conditions

Always use a good quality tripod to improve on the quality of your images

Be prepared keep your camera bag loaded and ready to go at all times. Just before the outing clean the lens, verify all the controls are working properly, the batteries are fully charged and you have enough camera cards to cover all the expected shots

Carry a plastic bag to protect your equipment incase of a sudden rain shower .

In conclusion Any phot expedition should be fun carry the bare minimum of equipment and enjoy your assignment only to be limited by your imagination..
