OUR 2019 FINANCES: YOUR PRAYERFUL CONSIDERATION REQUESTED

Dear friends in Christ,

The health of Christ's church is not measured by "nickels and noses." Rather our church is a reflection of the workings of the Holy Spirit. As Pastor Dan said in his June 9th sermon about Pentecost, the Holy Spirit gives us faith. This occurs because of the master plan that He has for each of us. We are each a conduit of the Holy Spirit, who has bestowed upon each of us various gifts to be used in accordance with His will regarding the master plan.

Each of us has the free will to choose how closely we listen to the conviction of the Holy Spirit and how much effort we place into His work. Our church has been greatly blessed over the years with many wonderful members and supporters who give very much of themselves, especially of their time, talents, and treasure.

The latter is always a concern as treasure is what keeps the physical church building maintained, the doors open, the lights on, and the ability to keep valuable staff who help the church not only operate smoothly, but also guide the flock in growing the spiritual maturity of the congregation.

Historically, Northland Lutheran Church sees slower times of the year in terms of financial donations, usually around summer. Then these build back up during the fall and crescendos just after Christmas services.

For 2019, our church approved an annual budget of just over \$90,000. Expenses and cost of living typically do not decrease, so our budget has been slightly increasing over time. Due in part to having the sanctuary floor refinished (\$2,200 in March) and the recent fill-up of the LP tanks (\$1,386 in May), we have been running deficits each month in 2019, except for April (Easter service helped a great deal—thank you!).

Here is the breakdown of the finances:

Jan.:	-\$2,655.31
Feb.:	-\$304.15
Mar.:	-\$1,750.74
Apr.:	+\$3,472.31
May:	-\$2,068.76

Because of the healthy savings we have, these costs are covered and all of our bills are up-to-date. However, as we all know, savings is there for a rainy day and should not be relied upon to balance a budget. And this is why we come to you with this level of detail.

The church council asks that you prayerfully consider this and requests any ideas you may have. During a brief fundraising brainstorming session at the June council meeting, suggestions ranged from hosting weekly fish boils for a month in the fall to hosting Saturday evening church services complete with a meal and a movie.

Northland Lutheran Church has demonstrated time and time again that our church has been blessed with a servant niche for supplying meals and fellowship. We can certainly explore more of these options as we are only limited by our energy and resources.

However, in closely reviewing last year's income report, we see that the majority of the income of just over \$75,000 came in from your very generous donations. Nearly \$11,000 of additional income was generated through land and facilities rentals, volunteer work at the Iola Old Car Show, and the Lutefisk Supper (the supper generated nearly \$4,700 in 2018).

As your elected council, we will prayerfully and responsibly do our best to be good stewards of the treasure you donate as the Holy Spirit touches your heart. We ask you to once again prayerfully consider the matter and give as you are convicted.

We are hopeful that the remainder of the year will see an upswing and balance out to meet our jointly agreed-upon budget. If it doesn't, we will very much need to look to areas to cut for our 2020 budget. We will certainly need your prayers at that time for the wisdom and guidance to meet our fiduciary responsibilities, but more urgently, your immediate prayers are very much needed to help us get back into "the black."

We ask for your prayers and request that you give accordingly.

Thank you so much for your previous support and for your prayerful consideration.

FROM THE DESK OF PASTOR DAN

I've been reading Charles Spurgeon's classic devotional "Morning & Evening" the last 4 months. It has a Scripture and devotion for morning and

night and I have found it helpful. Spurgeon believed that it is not always beneficial to read large chunks of the Bible in a short amount of time; this leads to rushing through the reading in order to get it over with quickly so we can do what we need to do. Spurgeon recommends that we take small sections of Scripture and take our time with it; meditate on it. In this relaxed state, the meaning of the passage, and its connection to our circumstances can be revealed to us. This doesn't happen all the time, and I have to say there are long stretches where the Holy Spirit seems to be far off. But if we give up on God's Word, we will not be able to receive it when we need it. The point is to stick with it over time. We may miss some days due to our responsibilities and whatever else we need to deal with. The point is that we accept the truth that this practice is necessary to the health of our Spiritual life. It is a day by day, one step at a time process that God uses to shape us over the course of our lives. Amen.
