FROM THE DESK OF PASTOR DAN

Matthew 10:36-39

Well-meaning family members can be your worst enemies. [37] If you prefer father or mother over me, you don't deserve me. If you prefer son or daughter over me, you don't deserve me.

[38] "If you don't go all the way with me, through thick and thin, you don't deserve me. [39] If your first concern is to look after yourself, you'll never find yourself. But if you forget about yourself and look to me, you'll find both yourself and me.

The Presbyterian pastor, Eugene Peterson, writes: "We outlive our past over and over again. There comes a moment when I am no longer a spouse, I am no longer a parent, I am no longer employed, I am no longer healthy. There are periods of my life that are immensely valuable and enjoyable and useful but which by their very nature cannot be perpetuated. Ironically, if we try to perpetuate them in the name of love, we ruin love. Detachment is not disloyalty; it is a requirement for the next movement of love, which is a movement into a more complete love. Such movements almost always being in feelings of loss and deprivation. But detachment is not loss—It is a precondition for new life and hope as we walk into the future."

As someone who lost two important people in my life last year I can relate to these words. Situations and relationships change over time. Circumstances come and go, as live into future situations and relationships.

Our past is very important to who we are in our lives. We are formed by our past. Yet, we were not created to get stuck in the past. When we lose family and friends who have always been there, there is now an empty space in our lives that cannot be replaced in the same way it was before. As we walk through these experiences, either as individuals, families, or a congregation, we must realize that the past cannot be duplicated in the present as it was before. God calls us into the future to walk with Him and He wants us to know that He is present with us as He leads us into a new future.

This is how we grow in our faith and relationship with God.

When Jesus spoke to his disciples concerning the fact that He would not always be with them, and that He would be crucified, His followers did not want to hear it. They wanted things to stay the same; they were comfortable with the way things were.

After Jesus was crucified, the disciples were at a loss. They floundered in the midst of grief and despair. Yet Jesus would not allow them to stay there. Jesus's Resurrection from death, gave them a new reality that empowered them with the presence of the Holy Spirit to walk with Him into the future. And He gave them the power and inspiration to continue what He started. Our God is a God of hope and new life; and He does not want us to get stuck in the past.

God speaks this same message to His people in the days of the Prophet Jeremiah where God says:

"For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope. Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart. I will be found by you, says the Lord, and I will bring you back from your captivity." Jeremiah 29:11-14

God is calling us into a new future, a new hope, and new life. Amen.


