The Exemplification Ceremony is scheduled for 10:30 a.m. on Saturday. The Saturday afternoon Mass will be conducted at the hotel at 4:00 p.m.

This year the Banquet will be served buffet style featuring beef and chicken entrees. We have been assured that this approach will enable faster service for all people attending the Banquet.

All Hospitality Rooms will be on the Atrium (pool) level with access to the Atrium as a shared celebration space. Fr. Vincent Capodanno Assembly has requested a suite for our Hospitality Room.

Hospitality Room

This year, Fr. Vincent Capodanno Assembly will again be hosting a Hospitality Room. The Assembly has requested a suite for both Friday and Saturday nights. The assignment of the Hospitality Rooms has not yet been completed. We will provide beverages and food for all who visit our Hospitality Room.

The Hospitality Room will be open Friday afternoon and evening; Saturday from the end of the Exemplification until time for the Mass and after the Banquet.

We need donations to provide snacks, appetizers, and desserts for all of these sessions. Wives of Sir Knights (and Sir Knights) are asked to prepare hot and cold foods for both days. Any and all types of foods are acceptable.

The only restriction on Hospitality Room foods is that no open flame heaters (chafing dishes, or Sterno cans) are allowed. Crock pots and electric hot plates are allowed.

Patriotic Wheelbarrow

It's time to start preparing for our Hospitality Room at the Spring Exemplification. The one project that has been a consistent part of our participation in the Spring Exemplification is the "Patriotic Wheelbarrow". This has been a great fundraiser for the Assembly to both pay the Exemplification expenses, but to also bring funds into the Assembly Treasury. The committee is now accepting donations for the wheelbarrow. Bring your donation to the assembly meeting in April, and they will be incorporated into the program.

Items for the Wheelbarrow can include beverages, patriotic display items, snacks, and any other entertainment item.
