GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING
APRIL 2, 2016

South Dakota Archers held their annual General Membership Meeting at 5:30 pm on April 2, 2016 at the Archery center in Yankton. Minutes of the last General Membership were read. Motion by Loyce May, second by Jennifer Raddatz to approve the minutes. Motion carried.

The annual Treasurers report was presented. Motion by Jordan, second by Tyler Pierce to approve the Treasurers report. Motion carried.

Minutes from the previous night's Board of Directors meeting were read.

Doug Ellis gave an update of hunting issues in the state. Jim Peterson is the SD Bowhunters President and our two organizations should work together. Doug mentioned bills that were introduced for the Senate and House to set game seasons which failed. Antelope season opens Aug 18th and Archery deer Sept 22 while May 20th is the deadline for EIK applications.

Elections: for NFAA director : Bill Hewes nominated Shorty Faber, Trent Withers second, Robbie Monrad nominated Jack Moulton , Tom Fullerton second. Ballots were passed out and votes counted. Shorty Faber is the NFAA director. Motion was made by Jennifer Raddatz, second by Mitch Benda to destroy the ballots. Carried .

For Bowhunter Director: Jennifer Raddatz nominated Doug Ellis, Shorty Faber Second. Jim Gleich moved that nominations cease, Tom Fullerton second and cast a unanimous ballot. The Southwest area elected Mike Long and the Northeast area elected Ronn McDaniel.

New Business: A motion was made by Doug Ellis, seconded by Tom Fullerton , that in order for a club to host the State Indoor they must have 10 adult NFAA members. Motion carried.

As there was no other new business, a motion was made Tom Fullerton and seconded by Jennifer Raddatz to adjourn. Meeting adjourned 6:20 pm.
