The state indoor in Mitchell was a well attended event again this year with around 130 archers participating along with attending the appreciation supper held on Saturday evening with Guy Tillet being the guest speaker. There were several door prizes given away at the banquet for the archers that were participating in the event. For those who missed it I think I can speak for everyone in attendance that you missed a great tournament, meal and speaker.

The spring season has been very slow at getting here and I am sure if you are like me are more than ready for winter to end and get outside. The second state NASP archery event was held in Rapid City the first part of April with a good attendance even with all of the budget cuts the schools are going through.
