

SDAA GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING

Minutes from the last General Membership meeting were read. Motion by Dave Cizadlo, second by Dwight Peschong to approve. Minutes approved.

Treasurers report was given for the year. Motion by Tom Fullerton, second by John Hanten Jr. to approve. Treasurers report approved.

The youth shooting at 15yds indoors was discussed. Motion by Don Iverson, second by Tammy Withers to continue to have the youth (12-14yr olds) shoot at 15yds at the State Indoor Championship. Motion carried unanimously.

Ideas for the website were discussed. It was mentioned that state records would be nice to have on the website. Kathy will try to work on this, at least with the records she has.

Discussion was had about the targets at a State 3D shoot having more than one vital. Jeff Russo made a motion to change the policy Article V, section E, third sentence to read: Any manufacturer's targets may be used. If targets with multiple vitals are used, there must be a sign at the shooting stake as to which vital to shoot. Tom Fullerton seconded. Vote was by a show of hands. 21 yeas, 5 nays. Motion carried.

Elections : Dave Cizadlo nominated Tim Withers for President, Dwight Peschong second. Tyler Pierce moved that nominations cease and cast a unanimous ballot. Motion carried. Tammy Withers nominated Jon Hardesty for Vice Pres., Kathy Faber second. Don Iverson moved that nominations cease and cast a unanimous ballot. Motion carried. Jeff Russo nominated Kathy Faber for Sec/Treas, Tammy Withers second. Dave Cizadlo moved that nominations cease and cast a unanimous ballot. Motion carried. Northwest area elected Larry Johnson as Governor, Southeast area elected Keith Hofer as Governor.

Tyler Pierce moved for the meeting to adjourn, second by John Hanten Jr., Meeting adjourned 6:35pm.
