It is recommended to not give a reason; you can get yourself in trouble. Tenure Managers, coaches and umpires do not have tenure in the league. Must be appointed/approved every year. So, if there is someone that has been a problem you do not have to make them a manager, coach or umpire.
- **Volunteers** you as a president set the precedent for having volunteers. Delegate jobs reach out to more people in your league. Build a Volunteer Base/List.
