- LL asked D4 to do experiment
 - 3 balls walk and 2 strikes for a strike out
- Definition of Doubleheader
 - Same 2 teams play in the same day

Geoffrey Shiu - ADA

- A's Little League days 4/23 vs. Seattle Mariners and 5/7 vs. Detroit Lions
 - Almost all sold out
- All coaches need Background checks
- Players not allowed to use "donut" style bat ring on bats while swinging bats
- Suggests 3 catchers helmets,
 - All catchers helmets require "Dangling" type throat protectors
- Entire team needs to wear Little League patches
 - If travel/other organization team, maybe Velcro/removable Little League patch for LL games
- 6 - 2 5/8 bats had to be removed from 1 major game
- Bases coaches shouldn't leave the dugout early in-between innings.
- Players should stay in the dugout and not be sitting with the fans during the game

Don Waddell - Chief Umpire

- Needs interleague rules for 60'
- Contracted Umpires
 - Background checks required
 - 7 leagues are providing contracted umpires
 - One company has backed out
 - Umpires must have a contract per Little League
 - Out of 7, none have completed contracts
 - Formal written contract is best
 - Outlining – background checks, liability, insurance, etc

- Umpires only need to be as skilled as the level of play
- Individual parents cannot get umpires on their own
