- A 12 year old may NOT pitch on any Minor tournament team
- Currently 5 teams signed up for the 11/12 Summer Baseball tournament
 - \$100, each team guaranteed 4 games, at least one game at Home, and every player will get a pin, 1st and 2nd place team will get medals
 - Volunteers, fields, scorekeepers, etc are needed
 - If this goes well, program will be extended to 9/10s next year\
- Currently 99 All-Star teams
- June 22nd is the All-Star Affidavit Verification day
 - Proof of Birth
 - 3 Proofs of Residency (CA DL [with valid date], Car Registration, Proof of Insurance)
 - Verification form
 - ALL paperwork in TRIPLICATE
 - Medical Releases not as necessary for 6/22, but needed for the games
- In the past it has been easy to add a player, this year will be harder
 - If a player needs to be added, please let Ted know ASAP and he will send a Board Member to the game to approve the player
- Managers and Coaches need a valid ID, and must present it before every game
- All-Stars can be announced June 6th
- Hope to have all Brackets done by Monday – on D4 website
- Binder Checklist to be sent out
- Approved waivers from last year should be okay, but bring them to Verification day if you have them
 - Email Ted names of players to see if he has a copy of any waivers

- All All-Star and TOC games will start at 5:30pm on weekdays and 11:00am on weekends**(subject to change for doubleheaders)
- After all tournaments, let Ted know if you like the East/West breakdowns
