TWHA Rules Apply to all classes.

**Points from this show are accepted by NCAHA Open Shows Awards, Arabian Horse Assoc. OEIP Awards, Appaloosa Competitive All-Breed Activities Program (ACAPP), APHA Paint Alternative Competition (PAC), and the AQHA All Breed Open Show Program. Participants in these programs are responsible for supplying the appropriate form & getting their forms signed.*

A \$5.00 per day office fee will be charged. If you do not scratch any classes this fee will be returned.

TACK HOLD will be no longer than 2 minutes. The gate will be closed after a 2 minute call.

"Scratches" must be submitted to the entry secretary on a "Scratch" form at least 3 classes in advance or the entry fee will be charged for the class! No Exceptions!

SPONSORSHIPS- \$20/CLASS. Accepted in advance or at the show. **Sign up early to get your name on the show program!**

"FORMAL" show attire not required; however, appropriate hat (no ball caps) & boots with heel are required. "Safety" helmets allowed in any class.

Arabian classes open to pure & part-breeds!

A "Novice" Rider or Horse is one having won 5 or fewer 1st places other than Halter in any division at any show prior to 1/1/2019. Riders 10 & under exempt. One horse classes will not to count toward the 5 1st places.

An "**Intermediate**" Horse or Rider is one which has NOT won an overall year end Division Championship in TWHA in the past three years. Additionally, "**Intermediate**" Rider is open to Non-Trainers, Non-Professional exhibitors only. If you are someone who has received money for training horses or giving lessons you are not an Intermediate rider. An Intermediate Horse or Rider cannot cross over between Novice and Intermediate classes.

Please contact **Rory Meacham** for advance **Stall Reservations** (919)906-3510. **Stalls will be tagged with your name.** If you do not make advance reservations for your stall(s) you will be assigned stall(s) upon arrival to the show grounds. **Stalls are restricted to Barns A & B only. Please see Myra Daniel or Monica Hagwood for stall assignments upon arrival to show grounds if you did not make reservations.**

Stalls are a flat fee of \$60 / day or for the weekend. Stalls are payable on your show tab. All stalls used for **ANY** purpose will be charged accordingly. Anyone not using a stall and showing out of your trailer will be charged a \$10.00 day fee per day. (This is a rule imposed by the Horse Complex not NCAHA or TWHA.)

Shavings will be available Friday 12-8 PM and Sat. 7 AM to noon from the barn office. Shavings will be **\$ 7.00/bag payable on delivery. Separate check for shavings!**

Negative Coggins test is required for admission to the show Grounds. State requirements are that you post your negative Coggins in the provided sleeve outside the stall door. If Coggins is not visible, you may be subject to state fine.

Working Western Classes will be judged by the American Ranch Horse Association Rules - with slight modifications. (See TWHA Rule Book.)

HIGH POINT AWARDS WILL BE GIVEN BASED ON 2-DAY TOTAL POINTS (ONE HORSE/ONE RIDER) FOR ADULT & YOUTH CHAMPION & RESERVE IN WESTERN, HUNT SEAT, SADDLESEAT AND WORKING WESTERN DIVISIONS. HORSE & RIDER MUST SHOW BOTH DAYS TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR AWARDS.

All classes (except leadline) count toward the high points in each division. Classes in the OPEN Division count toward whatever saddle type is used (Hunt, Saddleseat, Western or Working Western)

Division must be checked on entry form.

PLEASE REMEMBER!!

No Dogs allowed in the Arena or Cafeteria.
All dogs must remain on a leash at all times.

Negative Coggins MUST be posted on stall door or trailer and shown at time of entry.
