- Payback classes will be distributed when Show tab is settled and not before.
- TACK HOLD will be no longer than 2 minutes. The gate will be closed after a 2 minute call.
- A \$5.00 per day office fee will be charged for any exhibitor who has scratched a class. "Scratches" must be submitted to the entry secretary on a "Scratch" form at least 3 classes in advance or the entry fee will be charged for the class! No Exceptions!
- "FORMAL" show attire not required; however, appropriate hat (no ball caps) & boots with heel are required. "Safety" helmets allowed in any class. Shirts with NO Sleeves not permitted.
- A Novice Rider or Horse is one having won 5 or fewer 1st places other than Halter in any division at any show prior to 1/1/19. Riders 10 & Under are exempt from this rule. One horse classes will not count towards the 5 1st places.
- An **Intermediate Horse or Rider** is defined as someone or horse who has not won an overall all Division award in TWHA for the past 3 years. Intermediate Rider is open to Non-Trainers, Non-Professional exhibitors only. If you are a someone who has received money for Training horses or giving lessons you are not an Intermediate Rider. Intermediate Riders and Horses cannot cross over between Novice and Intermediate Classes.
- Horse/Rider combination must show both days to be eligible for High Point Awards.
- Working Western exhibitors may not cross over into the Open Division or the Western Division. However, they are allowed to show in the Hunt Seat or Saddle Seat division.
- Negative Coggins test is required for admission to the show Grounds.

DIRECTIONS: From Graham I-85/40 take exit 148 (Hwy 54) toward Chapel Hill. Go 8 miles and look for Talbert's Grocery on the left, **TURN RIGHT** onto Salem Church Road. Go approx. 1.5 miles. Look for a Church on the left; at the 3rd paved road after the church **TURN LEFT** at the Circle K Ranch sign. At the first paved road on the left, **TURN LEFT** and you will see the barn.
