Intermediate Rules:

1. Intermediate Horse or rider could not have Won an overall all Division award in TWHA for the past 3 years.
2. **Intermediate Rider** is open to Non-Trainers, Non-Professional exhibitors only. If you are a someone who has received money for Training horses or giving lessons you are not an Amateur rider.
3. Intermediate Horse or Rider cannot cross over between **Novice** and **Intermediate** classes.

Novice Classes

A **Novice Rider or Horse** is defined as a rider or horse who **has not yet received five (5) first place awards other than in Halter classes before January 1st of the current year in ANY DIVISION, AT ANY SHOW OPEN OR REGISTERED COMBINED.** Any 1st place ribbons received by any one ages 10 & under will not be applied to the Novice rule. Number of 1st place ribbons will only count when the exhibitor is of the age of 11 or older. Any 1 horse classes will be exempt from counting towards the 5 1st place rule for both rider and horse, both youth and adult exhibitors.
