## 2018 All Around High Point Performance Rider

For the 2018 Show Season, All Around Performance Horses (Larry Hill and Caroline Snow) have donated to TWHA a DC Western Custom Work Saddle to be given to the All Around High Point Performance Rider.

## **RULES:**

- 1. Award Winner must be a TWHA member in good standing.
- 2. Points are awarded as above on 1st -5th places: 5, 4, 3, 2, 1.
- 3. All Mandatory and Optional Classes will count towards this award.
- 4. Points are accumulated on the Exhibitor only, Any number of horses can be included and does not have to be the same horse in these three divisions.
- 5. Rider/Exhibitor must compete in 50% of 2 Performance Divisions (Western, Hunt Seat, Saddle Seat, or Working Western) and 50% of the Halter Division for a total of 3 Divisions to be eligible. (meaning, exhibitor must complete in at least 2 division of either Western, Hunt Seat, Saddle Seat or Working Western and compete in Halter. Any number of horses can be included and does not have to be the same horse in these three divisions). Any Horse entering the Working Western Division may not cross over to any other Western Pleasure classes during that show and vice versa.
- 6. Award is open to Non-Trainers, Non-Professional and Amateur exhibitors only. If you are a Trainer and have received money for Training horses or giving lessons you are not eligible for this award.
- 7. Horse/rider must show all 3 divisions at 50% of TWHA-approved shows for the current year & be a TWHA member. Number of shows required will be set each year by the Board of Directors before the start of TWHA-sanctioned shows. It may vary from year to year. (Remember: Rider/Handler must be TWHA member(s) at time points are won for points to count.)
- 8. Points are counted from ALL HALTER, WESTERN OR WORKING WESTERN, HUNT SEAT, SADDLESEAT, MISCELLANEOUS TWHA MANDATORY & OPTIONAL CLASSES printed on class sheet for show (as above).
- 9. <u>In the case of a tie</u> regarding high point winners (High point at an individual show or year-end awards) <u>the winner will be determined by the exhibitor that has entered the greatest</u> number of classes.
