# CONVENTION

- Primary responsibility is to assist with crowd control during any activities regarding the Convention.
- Responsible for maintaining an atmosphere of recovery and respect for the facility where the Convention is held.
- Assures that limited personal and property damage occurs and that NDACNA Convention policy guidelines are followed.
- Functions as a liaison between the convention committee and the facility.
- Holds periodic and special meetings as necessary. Distributes flyer requesting participation that includes meeting dates.

This Committee should be made up of members who have a minimum of **six months** (6) clean time and have shown *stability* in their recovery.

The **SK** subcommittee is not a police action body and there is no need for any Committee member to intervene on any other member when they chose to act in an unacceptable manner.

The **SK** member should first contact the Chair and/or Vice-chair to advise them of the incident taking place and allow them to take appropriate action, which is usually contacting the facility security and/or management.

Members of the NDACNA 2020 Subcommittee should never take any action toward the members attending the function. We are not police.
